I hereby have the pleasure of officially announcing the **Fourth bi-Annual Catholic Student Union Alumni Retreat Reunion!** As on the other years, this amazing time together will be held on **the weekend of May 23rd**, Memorial Day weekend (beginning 7 pm on Friday and officially ending Sunday afternoon).

Our reunions continue to grow – If you recall...

2002: was held at a camp in Central Florida with **68 adults and 6 children** (under 6)

2004: in Santa Rosa, FL there were **62 adults and 11 children** (under 6)

2006: Marywood Retreat Center in Jacksonville we had **108 adults and 33 children** (under 6)

2008: we will again use **Marywood Retreat Center** but this time we have gotten the whole facility for our use. (Maybe this year there will be some kids over 6 years old???)

As we keep on growing we will probably need to find another venue for the next retreat.

Marywood Retreat Center in Jacksonville, FL (www.marywoodcenter.org) is easy to get to, has a big airport nearby, good accommodations and some of our alumni living nearby may be able to host any overflow crowds.

Also, as on the 2006 reunion retreat a number of current CSU women will be volunteering to assist your families with baby-sitting services, which (Praise God!) is a bigger issue every year.

Themes and all that...

As before, our venue will include lots of hang-out time, time to deepen our faith through teachings and witnesses, and of course, prayer and mass.

We are currently developing the Theme for the retreat along the lines of Spirituality of Mission. We've got some ideas, but trust me you'll love it. And, if you have any ideas of possible topics, workshops that might be useful please let us know. So far we have the brothers currently at FSU (Br. Allen, Br. Stephen, Br. Jason and me, Br. Ted) coming however there may be a surprise guest or two if we can finagle it.
